

# **PRACTICAL ASTROLOGY FOR DAILY LIVING**

## **COURSE INFORMATION**

### **MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR COURSE PARTICIPATION**

1. There is no educational requirement to participate in and receive a Certificate of Training for this course, but the student must possess an above average intelligence, speak, read and write fluent English at a high level, be powerfully motivated and possess a keen interest to quickly comprehend the signs, symbols and concepts of astrology.
2. Participants must have full access to a computer and the Internet and have an email address.
3. Participants must pay the registration fee in advance and the Enrollment Fee for the course, due at the first meeting.
4. Participants must maintain an acceptable standard of progress in the process of learning the practice of astrology, as measured by achieving passing scores on random pop quizzes & scheduled tests given during the course to qualify for The Certification Examination.
5. Participants must complete the full course to be issued a Certificate of Training and pass The Certification Examination. If a class session is missed for any reason the Certification Examination cannot be taken and no certificate will be issued until the student makes up the missed class(es) by attending that (those) missed class(es) for a fee in the next Course offered.
6. Participants must be punctual and ready to begin the class at the exact time scheduled. "Hawaiian Time" is an illusion; Tardiness will not be tolerated.

### **REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS AND PROCESS**

1. The Minimum class size is 10 students – maximum is 15.
2. Registrations received after the maximum class size has been reached will be assigned to the next class formed, or refunded in full, if the Registrant submits a written request for a refund.
3. The registration deadline date is February 2, 2005.
4. Late registrations will be accepted with a 20% late fee up to the maximum class size of 15 students until the day of the **COURSE ENROLLMENT – FIRST CLASS MEETING**.

### **REFUND POLICY**

1. There is a 15% processing charge for refunds requested prior to five days before the Course Enrollment – First Class Meeting.
2. A 25% penalty withdrawal option is offered at the Course Enrollment – First Class Meeting, after the Introductory Lecture.

### **COURSE ENROLLMENT – FIRST CLASS MEETING OBJECTIVES**
